HANDICAPPED STUDENTS

The Board of Trustees of the West Hills Community College District actively supports the principles established by the passage of Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (public law 93-112) and makes every effort to see that handicapped students are “mainstreamed” or “integrated” into the regular program. The Act provides that:

“...no qualified handicapped person shall, on the basis of a handicap, be excluded from the participation in, or be denied benefits of, or otherwise be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity which receives or benefits from federal assistance.”

The District Comprehensive Plan for Handicapped Students is on file at each campus and available for inspection during normal working hours.
