

STUDENT ADMISSIONS

It shall be the policy of the Board to admit every qualified person regardless of race, color, religion, creed, sex, economic status and handicap.

To qualify for admission under this policy the following conditions are established:

1. Students who are high school graduates or equivalent
2. Non-graduates of high school who are eighteen (18) years of age or over, and can profit from the programs offered.
3. Transfer students from other accredited schools are admitted with regard to status provided they have met the College's Scholarship Standards. Students disqualified from another college or with cumulative grade points below 2.0 G.P.A. will be admitted on probation.
4. Elementary and high school students under special conditions and in compliance with the Education Code may be admitted.
5. Special admission procedures such as additional testing, completion of special application forms, and personal interviews may be required for admission to certain of the District's programs.
